**NOTICE OF ADOPTION**  
**Ordinance #433**  
**To Repeal the Existing Chapter 1045 of Title Four of Part 10 of the**  
**City of Coopersville's Code of Ordinances**

The City of Coopersville Council members adopted Ordinance #433 at a regular City Council meeting held on February 14, 2011 which is an ordinance to repeal the existing chapter 1045 ("Sewage Disposal System") of title four ("utilities") of part 10 ("Streets, Utilities and Public Services") of the City of Coopersville Code of Ordinances, and to enact a new chapter 1045 ("Sewer Use and Pretreatment") of Title Four ("Utilities") of Part 10 ("Streets, Utilities and Public Services") of the City of Coopersville Code of ordinances, to regulate the use of public and private sewers and drains, private sewage disposal, sewer installations and connections and discharges of wastewater and pollutants into the City's publicly owned treatment works ("POTW"); to require pretreatment of nondomestic wastes by users of the POTW, user permits, and monitoring and reporting of users; and to provide for enforcement, penalties, and other relief for violations.
