- Height of signs allowed should be five and one half (5 1/2) feet instead of five (5)
- Square footage of signs allowed should be eight (8) square feet instead of six (6)
- Placement of temporary directional signs from any sign of the same subdivision should be changed from two hundred (200) feet to three hundred ninety seven (397) feet
