Motion by Council member Whitman with second by Council member Scherff to approve payment on the invoice from Lemmen & Lemmen PLC for court services totaling \$97.50. Carried unanimously. (2008-174)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Sprague to approve payment on the invoices from OMM Engineering, Inc. totaling \$1,967.50. Carried unanimously. (2008-175)

Motion by Council member Sprague with second by Council member Vander Kolk to approve the checks written for the period ending August 11, 2008 totaling \$115,575.45. Carried unanimously. (2008-176)

Motion by Council member Scherff with second by Council member Meintsma to adopt a resolution transferring 25% of \$15,671.19 or \$3,917.80 from Major Roads to Local Roads. Carried unanimously. (2008-177)
