Mayor Kenneth L. Bush called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M.

There were no additions or corrections to the agenda.

Motion by Council member Lloyd with second by Council member Whitman to approve the minutes of the regular City Council meeting of March 22, 2010. Carried unanimously. (2010-080)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Meintsma to approve the minutes of the special City Council meeting of March 24, 2010 with corrections. Carried unanimously. (2010-081)

In the discussion Council member Allen moved that her vote on Resolution 2010-078 be changed from Yes to No and recorded as a correction in the minutes for the March 24, 2010 special meeting. Mayor Bush ruled this an improper motion.

Mayor Bush opened the floor for citizens' comments. There were none.

Motion by Council member Whitman with second by Council member Lloyd to approve the invoice from Law Weathers for general municipal totaling \$380.00. Carried unanimously. (2010-082)

Motion by Council member Crandle with second by Council member Allen to approve the checks written for period ending April 12, 2010 totaling \$82,890.34. Carried unanimously. (2010-083)

Motion by Council member Meintsma with second by Council member Lloyd to approve the city clerk contract for Kimberly K. Borgman with the following conditions:

- that the probationary period be for 90 days; and
- that item "3." be corrected to read, ... "5.2 (a)" not "5.2 (b)."

Motion carries 4-3 with Council members Crandle, Allen and Whitman voting no. (2010-084)

The oath of office was issued to new City Clerk Kimberly Borgman by City Manager, Steve Patrick.

Motion by Council member Lloyd with second by Council member Vander Kolk to adopt Ordinance 425 to adopt by reference the 2010 International Property Maintenance Code. Motion carries 4–3 with Council members Crandle, Allen and Whitman voting no. (2010–085)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Lloyd to adopt Ordinance 426 to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages. Motion carries 6–1, with Council member Crandle voting no. (2010–086)

Motion by Council member Whitman with second by Council member Meintsma to approve Ordinance 427 to adopt by reference the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code. Motion carries 6–1, with Council member Crandle voting no. (2010–087)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Allen to receive and file the FY 2009–2010 Revenue/Expenditure Reports for quarter ending 3/31/10. Carried unanimously. (2010–088)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Lloyd to receive and file the council information packet which consists of: approval letter for City of Coopersville Water Supply Reliability Study; Ottawa County Northeast Quadrant meeting notice; Charter 3/27/10 correspondence; Michigan Municipal League 3/16/10 correspondence; Consumers Energy Notice of Hearing; Historical Society's 4/2010 newsletter; and the Emergency Services 1/4/10, 1/18/10, 2/1/10, 2/15/10, 3/1/10 and 3/15/10 minutes. Carried unanimously. (2010–089)

Mayor Bush again opened the floor for citizens' comments.

Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Cynthia Timmerman:

- thanked Kim Borgman;
- reported on the successful grand opening of BE Lovely, a new business on Main St.;
- announced that the Farmers' Market will open on May 5<sup>th</sup> and will now be non-smoking, and will promote local products and produce; and
- announced three new businesses in town.

Citizen Adrian Brown briefly addressed the council.

City Manager Patrick and council members thanked the person that filled in while the city searched for a new clerk.

City Clerk Borgman reported that the election workers have been appointed, the absentee voter applications have been processed, and that the ballot containers have been certified for the school board election in May.
