City Resident, Tom Muller inquired about the Council's logic for wanting to put sidewalks on 64th Avenue between Main and Randall Street. Mr. Muller expressed his concern for a greater need of sidewalks by Eagle Ridge where the population is of a greater number. City Manager, Steven Patrick explained to Mr. Muller that the Council members would be reviewing the Capital Improvement Policy and setting the priorities of future projects as needed.

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Lloyd to appoint Larry Longstreth to the Zoning Board of Appeals as a regular member upon recommendation by Mayor Bush. Carried unanimously. (2010-218)
