Motion by Council member Fisher with second by Council member Vander Kolk to approve the October 22, 2012 regular meeting minutes. Motion carried. (2012-222)

Sgt. Dennis Luce of the Ottawa County Sheriff's Department, Coopersville Branch presented a PowerPoint presentation on Policing Services in the City of Coopersville and a Speed Study that he has recently completed.

Sgt. Dennis Luce also informed Council members that he recently completed and graduated from a ten (10) month Staff and Command Class that was held through Northwestern University.

**Citizen Input & Suggestions**

Jan Ver Berkmoes informed Council members that she is interested in being appointed to the Downtown Development Board to fill a current vacant seat.

Greg DeJong, County Commissioner informed Council members that this month ends his ability to serve the Coopersville area due to the redistricting. Greg stated that it has been a privilege to serve and he appreciates the relationship he has had with Coopersville. Greg stated that he will soon be representing the entire County.

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Fisher to approve payment on invoices from OMM Engineering for 2<sup>nd</sup> Grand River Water Main Crossing \$7,990.00, upgrading the WWTP \$1,277.00, and Randall Street Phase 2 \$168.75, totaling \$9,435.75. Motion carried. (2012-224)

Motion by Council member Crandle with second by Council member Meintsma to approve payment on checks written for period ending November 12, 2012 totaling \$205,267.77. Motion carried. (2012-225)

Motion by Council member Vander Kolk with second by Council member Fisher to approve the speed recommendations presented by Sgt Luce as follows:

Campus Drive between 48 <sup>th</sup> /CAPS	25 to 30 MPH
Center Street between Cleveland/Spring	25 to 30 MPH
Main Street between 64 <sup>th</sup> /Center	25 to 30 MPH
Randall Street between West/East	25 to 30 MPH
Spring Street between 64 <sup>th</sup> /Center	25 to 30 MPH

Council member Crandle stated his concerns on raising the speed limit on Center Street by the bridge as there are no sidewalks in that area and he felt that the City should address that issue in the near. Sgt. Luce also noted the same in his recommendations. Motion carried. (2012-226)

Motion by Council member Lloyd with second by Council member Ward to approve the resolution for the 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan. Motion failed with Council members Crandle, Vander Kolk, Meintsma, and Mayor Bush opposing. Council member Crandle requested that Council members need more time to review the plan. Further action postponed until the November 26, 2012 Council meeting.

Motion by Council member Lloyd with second by Council member Meintsma to receive and file Council information which consists of: Permits issued for October; Coopersville/Polkton Area Fire Protection Authority meeting minutes of 10/9/12. Motion carried. (2012-227)
